
2020-2021 ... A Great Year for Ponca Community Educational Foundation, Inc.

PCEF Announces "Ponca Promise" Pilot Program for the 2021-2022 School Year

Ponca Community Educational Foundation, Inc., (PCEF) is excited to announce that for the 2021-2022 school year they plan to pilot a new program for Ponca High School seniors who take college credit classes. As part of the "Ponca Promise." the PCEF will reimburse eligible seniors partial tuition for up to two college credit classes taken from Northeast Community College, pending the students earn at least a "B" or higher grade or 3.0000 or higher on a 4.0000 point scale.

How did the "Ponca Promise" come to fruition? In 2019, with the support of many generous donors, the PCEF sponsored a fundraiser in which a 2019 Polaris Ranger was raffled off. Proceeds from this raffle were used as seed money to establish an account called the "Ponca Promise." Additional donations have been given to the PCEF to build this fund. These donations would provide the source for tuition funding for Ponca High School students who qualify to enroll in college credit classes during their senior year. The PCEF Board of Directors developed this program for two reasons: 1. To promote the importance of higher education for students of the Ponca School District. 2. To help alleviate some financial burden incurred

by Ponca graduates who are advancing their post high school education while still in high school.

The long term goal of PCEF is to build the Ponca Promise account enough that eventually all iuniors and all seniors (who meet the criteria to take college credit classes) could be reimbursed at least partial tuition for completing college credit classes pending the students earn at least a "B" or higher grade or 3.0000 or higher on a 4.0000 point scale while enrolled at Ponca High School.

After the first year of the Ponca Promise, the PCEF Board of Directors plan to evaluate the program for feedback, effectiveness, and

for continued improvements to this program.

New Option to Establish an Endowment through the P.C.E.F.

At the annual meeting on January 19, 2021, the PCEF Board of Directors voted to develop a new option for donors wishing to establish an endowment through the Foundation, Individuals, families, businesses or organizations will now be able to establish a new endowment using a three-year pledge option. The minimum amount needed to start an endowment is \$7500. Donors may now pledge to meet that minimum amount over a three year pledge period. A pledged endowment of \$7,500 must be paid in full at the end of the third pledge year in order for the endowment to be awarded according to the donor(s) guidelines.

What is an endowment?

An investment fund which is typically funded by donations that are tax deductible for the donor. Usually the principal stays in the account and the annual accrued interest is awarded and distributed according to guidelines used for specific purposes which the donor has requested.



The initial use of the multi-media computerized projection system was enjoyed by students and staff for the 2020-2021 Virtual Veterans Day Program.

In April, 2020 the PCEF teamed up with the Gilchrist Foundation and the Ponca School District to fund and install a multimedia projection system for Ponca Public School's West Gym. (This project grant request fit into the ARTS and PUBLIC BROADCASTING area of interest of the Gilchrist Foundation.)

Our new system includes a laser projector with 4K support, rear projection screen, and miscellaneous video and audio accessories. The west gym, built in 1974, houses the new system and is used for a variety of school and community events including: graduation, Professional Development Days, Veterans Day Program, music programs, Orphan Grain Train Packaging Event, Red Ribbon Week multimedia presentations, and others. It is also utilized for community events including: Alumni Banquet. Ponca Craft Fair, public concerts. dispensing site for community disasters, funerals, community speakers, and public movie nights. We are excited about the other fine arts events this system will support in the future.

Ponca School's technology team is especially excited to have modern, computerized equipment which does not require assembly and disassembly after each use. This system provides a high quality viewing experience of multimedia presentations for our students and community members at our existing events. Another outstanding benefit of our new multimedia projection system is that several of our instructors can now display/host new events that promote fine arts and cultural diversity for our students and for our community members. Two new specific examples include our Spanish department plans to host Spanish Cultural Day at Ponca School and our art teacher plans to display student artwork electronically during parent teacher con-
